Join Hybrid Press Conference on 4th International Dignified Menstruation Day – December 8, 2022

Kathmandu, Nepal (November 25, 2022) To commemorate the 4th International Dignified Menstruation Day (IDM Day) during the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence (Nov. 25 thru Dec. 10), the Global South Coalition for Dignified Menstruation (<u>GSCDM</u>), Radha Paudel Foundation (<u>RPF</u>), in partnership with the AIDS Healthcare Foundation (<u>AHF</u>), will hold a hybrid (virtual and in-person) press conference on Thursday, December 8, 2022. GSCDM/RPF and AHF urge all governments, UN agencies, and stakeholders to commemorate this day and promote Dignified Menstruation for all people who menstruate globally.

This year, nearly 60 countries worldwide will celebrate the 4th IDM Day under the theme "Dignified Menstruation for Ending Child Marriage." In Nepal, government agencies, stakeholders, and academia in all seven provinces will commemorate IDM Day by conducting various programs focused on Dignified Menstruation.

More than 200 participants from around the world are expected to attend the joint GSCDM/RPF-AHF hybrid press conference, where Terri Ford from AHF, Mon Sry Ka (AHF Cambodia), Jullian Eleina Palmario Tumbali (AHF Philippines), Anahi Rodriguez from Mexico, Bridget from Uganda, Jamil Kigenyi from Uganda, Yeanoh Rukoh Bai Kamara and Tity Memunatu Sannoh from Sierra Leone will be speaking at the event. Ms. Radha Paudel, an expert on Dignified Menstruation, will share the urgency of Dignified Menstruation to end GBV. GSCDM/RPF will also use the press conference to announce the winners of the global Video Competition and Nepal's Media Call. In addition, dedicated campaigners will be honored with a certificate.

 - o GSCDM and its members (from more than 50 countries)
 - o Radha Paudel Foundation (RPF) (secretariat for GSCDM)
 - AIDS Healthcare Foundation (AHF) and Girls Act

Similarly, on the 4th IDM Day, the Sri Lanka Chapter of GSCDM will conduct a virtual conference under various thematic areas, such as Dignified Menstruation, menstrual hygiene, taxation, waste management, education, physical resources, climate justice, Dignified Menstruation and law, menstrual discrimination, economic development, and political participation. Leaders and activists will also present papers based on these themes. Likewise, the Africa Chapter of GSCDM will be marking the 4th IDM Day for the 1st time in their region with the activities like an engaging media house to advocate for Dignified Menstruation at hospitals, schools, and the community level.
